- Mark making, letter formation and writing names and captions using a variety of different media.

- Reading names and labels in different places.

Maths

- Looking at and exploring numbers in the environment.
- Enjoying counting and ordering activities
- Playing number games
- To use everyday language to talk about size and position

Physical Development

- Developing and improving fine motor control.
- Experimenting with different ways of moving
- Using small apparatus such as balls, hoops and bats
- Practising getting dressed and undressed

Expressive Arts and Design

- Painting and printing using and mixing colours
- Creating simple representations of fruit and vegetables
- Playing in the 'Kitchen'
- Manipulating different materials
- Joining in singing songs and nursery rhymes
- Improving construction skills
