Personal, Social and Emotional Development

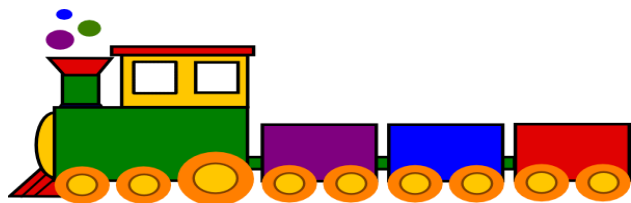
- Sharing our favourite toys and asking and answering questions about them.

Literacy

- Mark making, letter formation and writing names and captions using a variety of different media.
- Exploring different stories and nursery rhymes such as 'The Train ride', 'Lost Teddy' and 'Miss Polly had a Dolly'
- Developing phonic and rhyming knowledge
- Reading names and labels in different places.

Maths

- To show an interest in shapes, naming and describing both 2d and 3d.
- Enjoying counting, estimating and ordering activities
- To use positional language
- To use everyday language related to time.

Physical Development

- Developing and improving fine motor control, holding pencil correctly and using one handed tools.
- Experimenting with different ways of moving on and around large equipment.
- Using small apparatus such as balls, hoops and bats
- Practising getting dressed and undressed

Expressive Arts and Design

- Making and using malleable materials.
- Creating simple toys using reclaimed and construction materials.
- Playing in the 'Kitchen'
- Joining in singing songs and nursery rhymes
- Listening and moving to music from different countries and cultures
- Designing and making Christmas cards
