Food, Glorious Food!

English: Reading continues to be a focus to develop. Our guided reading sessions will focus on increasingly developing vocabulary, retrieving information, summarising the text and talking about simple inferences. The written work this term will be on Traditional Stories such as Goldilocks and the Three Bears, Snow White (and Snow White with a difference) and the Three Billy Goats

Gruff. We aim to try to write our own versions of the story. We will continue, as always, to focus heavily on phonics and word building to become more fluent readers and writers. Please could we urge you to keep going with phonics practise at home.

Maths: We will be learning mathematical language and problem solving. We will be making comparisons and collecting data. We will be learning about money, including ordering and comparing coins. We will continue to focus on counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will also be learning how to use standard and non-standard units of measurements.

R.E: We will be listening to some of the stories from the Old Testament to include the story of Moses the Baby.

Science: This term's delicious topic is food. The children will be thinking about the food we eat, its health benefits and ensuring we know what it means to eat a healthy and balanced diet. They will also look at fitness and how our bodies change during exercise.

History: We have a very small history focus this term but it seems fitting to look at our Monarchy briefly, in the light of the upcoming Royal Wedding.

Computing: Last term, the children started learning how to use algorithms. This term, we will continue to improve our programming skills, using Scratch Jr app. The children will be creating backgrounds and moving characters to produce their own stories.

Music: This term, the children will be learning about rhythm and creating a beat using body percussion.

P.E: We will be having P.E lessons on Monday and Thursdays and will continue to swim on Fridays. This term we will be practising dance skills and taking part in gymnastic sessions.

D&T: We will be using cutting, chopping, grating and mixing techniques to cook food that can be found around the UK

Art: We will be using fruit and vegetables for observational drawings and printing.

Homework: The children will be having weekly spelling and reading homework

in the same format as last half term. Spelling will be sent home on a Friday and tested the following Thursday.
