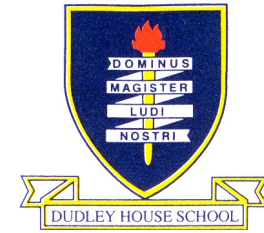


Week 2 April 23rd
