What are we learning this week?



This term we are we will be supporting the children's learning through teaching and learning activities based around Celebrations and Toys.

Welcome back to Class 1. We hope you had an enjoyable holiday and ready to embark on what will be a very busy term.

This week, we will be learning about Diwali and keeping safe on our roads and on Bonfire Night. The children will be learning finding out how Hindu people celebrate Diwali. We will be listening to Indian music, making Divas and Rangoli patterns. We will be talking about Keeping Safe on the roads and making Stop signs. We will also be discussing how to stay safe on Bonfire night. Some children will be continuing to learn to read and write Phase 2 and 3 letters as well as learning to read key words and blending sounds to make words. We will be working with different shapes in Maths creating pictures and patterns.
