

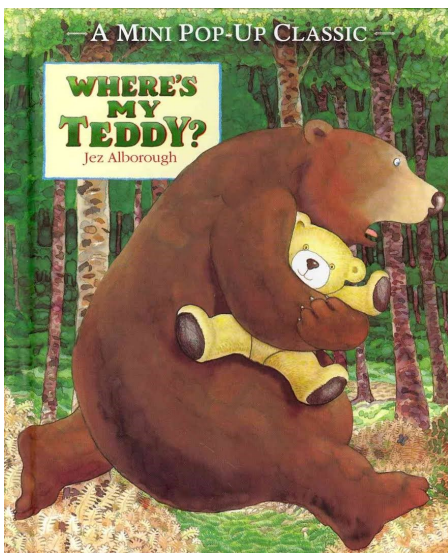

# What are we learning this week?
