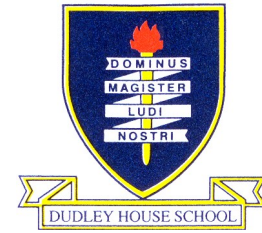


Week 2 June 11th
