What's been happening

International Bomber Command Visit – 25th September

The children in class 3 and 4 certainly learnt some fascinating information about World War II on their visit to Bomber Command in Lincoln and asked some very thought-provoking questions. They worked as a team to fly a bombing raid, researched to find answers to questions, explored artefacts and remembered individuals who served in the war, by placing a poppy on their name.

Library visit – 30th September 2019

Class 3 and 4 had a wonderful time learning how to use the library and about the services Grantham Library offers. They enjoyed games to help them understand how to find different types of resources and listened to a range of poetry in preparation for Poetry Day later in the week.

Evacuee Day – 1st October

The air raid siren went off in the classroom intermittently throughout the day, but all the children were kept safe in the class Anderson shelter. From a maths mission from Winston Churchill, to knitting, to poetry and cookery. A fun day was had by all!
