We ask that any food provided is vegetarian. If your child has specific dietary requirements (dairy free, gluten free, vegan or nut allergy etc.) we ask that you provide something specific for them to enjoy, if they are unable to eat vegetarian food. Party food will need to be bought to school on Thursday morning and put in the kitchen.

Party and play clothes can worn instead of school uniform, but please make sure that your child still has sensible shoes and a coat for outdoor play.

Children should bring their fruit snack and water bottle for the morning as usual.

The children, who have music lessons with Mrs Dawson will be playing the pieces they have been learning in the school hall on the last day of term. Parents are very welcome to attend.
