## **Arrangements for children who need to attend school.**

We have several pupils who are classed as critical worker children [see list](#) and need to attend school from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March.

The gate will open at **8:30am** and children will be supervised on the playground by a member of staff. All children will then go into class 3 where they will complete learning set by their class teacher with either Mrs Beckett or Mrs Stukins. The teachers will take it in turns to supervise the class.

If children have taken home their learning packs or PE bags please can they bring them into school as they will need these.

Children should come in their normal school uniform and coat.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch as normal and Miss Garner will supervise them at lunchtime.

Children should be collected from class 3's external door at 3:30pm, (12:30pm on Fridays). Parents should not come into the building unless vital.

At present we have cancelled afterschool and Friday clubs as most children who will be in school do not usually attend these. If this poses a problem, please let us know and we will see what we can do.

In order to cater most effectively for the children who need to attend school please can you confirm whether your child will need to attend every day, or whether they can or you would prefer them to attend part time and if so which days.
