Re: Coronavirus update – reminder of school closure to most pupils

I'm writing to remind you that school will be closed to almost all children **from Monday morning until further notice**. Instead the children will be expected to be learning at home. Staff have sent home a pack of activities for them to complete and will be emailing more activities after the Easter holiday

While we regret that this is the situation, we have to follow the latest government advice.

Therefore, we do not expect to see your children on Monday unless:

- Any parent or carer in your household is a critical worker and you won't be able to care for your child or children at home. (See who counts as a critical worker [here](#).) It's up to you to decide as a family whether your child comes into school in this instance. We will support them in school if you need us to
- They have a child protection plan
- They have an education, health and care plan
- They need other specialist support – in which case the school, or your social worker will contact you directly.

If your child falls into one of the categories above and you haven't already told us, please let us know immediately. Please email headteacher@dudleyhouseschool.co.uk or text or ring 07483 455997.

I know this is a difficult time for many of you, and the next few weeks will be an adjustment for all of us. We are doing everything we can to support your children and families at this time and appreciate your patience and support. Please do help us by following the advice set out above.
