Dear Class 3 Parents,

The government keeps on urging us all to stay at home because of the extremely high number of people being infected with coronavirus and the increasing number of people dying each day. As a result, the government updated its guidance to schools at the end of last week, which now states: *'Parents and carers who are critical workers should keep their children at home if they can.'*

Therefore, we urge you to keep your children at home if you can, so that we can reduce the risk of transmission in our community and help keep everyone safe.

We will remain open for those children of critical workers who have no alternative but to be in school.

To improve even further the remote learning that we are providing for our children, this week teachers will be starting teaching some lessons live online via Zoom. They will teach the children both online at home and in school at the same time, and then set work for them to complete independently. They will provide children with the resources they will need to complete their learning at home (these can be picked up on Monday evening for those not already learning from home). This means that all children will be receiving the same provision whether at school or at home.

Below is the timetable for this week for Class 3. Please be ready to start on time.

2:00 – 3:00	Home learning task set by your teacher

During a meeting:

- Everyone must wear suitable clothing – no pyjamas, as should anyone else in the household.
- Any devices used should be in appropriate areas and in a quiet space where the children can complete their work.
- We suggest that for the younger children there is a parent present nearby.
- Language must be appropriate, including any family members in the background.
- If children wish to speak they should raise their hand, just like they do in class, and wait until the person leading the meeting asks them to speak.
- Meetings will be recorded for school use, so that if any issues were to arise, the video can be reviewed.

Each lesson will have its own password encrypted link. It is vitally important that this link is not shared with anyone else. Once you have clicked on the link, just before the meeting is about to start, you will go into a waiting room and Mrs Johnson will only admit those people to the meeting whose names she recognises. Once the meeting has started it will be locked so that others can't join.

In order for your child to access these meetings you must give permission by completing and returning the attached permission form.
