Information about returning to school

Dear Parents,

We are really looking forward to all the children being back in school on Monday 8th March. We can't wait, and I am sure that you can't either.

We have reviewed all the protocols and procedures that we have put in place to keep everyone safe and minimise the spread of the virus and feel that they work very effectively. We have made just a couple of tweaks.

Face Coverings

Since January we have asked all parents to wear a face covering whilst on the school site to help minimise the spread of the virus. Please continue to do this.

Children do not need to wear a face covering.

Before School

All children should now arrive at school between 8:40 and 8:45am and line up by the gate, where they will then be sent one at a time to enter their classroom, through the external propped open door.

Children should bring their bag (containing their lunch box, water bottle, fruit snack and book bag, along with their PE kit, if this is not currently in school). Please ensure that your child arrives on time

End of day

With our low numbers we feel that children should all be able to be collected at the same time. Therefore, children should be collected at 3:30 pm (Monday to Thursday) and at 12:30pm on a Friday.

Parents in class 1 should wait by the holly trees near the metal gate and collect their children from class 1 door. Class 2 and 3 parents should wait near the staff cars and children will continue to be sent out of the front door in families.

To help ensure everyone maintain a good social distance at all times, we would please ask:

- for only one parent to come on to the school site at present
- people to walk up the carpark side of drive and down the school side
- leave the site promptly
- avoid congregating at the bottom of the drive and blocking the exit for others.

Extra-Curricular clubs and After School Clubs

Due to restriction still in place we are delaying, starting before school care and afterschool clubs until after Easter. If this poses difficulties please speak to Mrs Johnson.

As always, children must not attend school if they or a member of their household has any symptoms of Coronavirus.
