Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome Back! I hope you've had a great half term break and managed to stay safe and well. What wonderful weather we enjoyed!

We were very sad to say 'Goodbye' to Archie and his family at the end of last term. They will be greatly missed and we wish them every happiness in their new life in Ireland.

I just wanted to let you know about this term and what we are going to be up to in Class 1. Our Topic is called: Summer Days and I have listed below the weekly themes that we will be focussing upon -

WB: 7.6.21	Literacy: The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch story – predictive writing, recounts and speech bubbles Maths: Rec – Finding the whole and missing parts, Nurs - Numbers to 10
WB: 14.6.21	Literacy: Lighthouse Keepers lunch – fact finding, information texts, letter writing Maths: Rec – 10 and some more, Nurs – Comparing groups and counting/more or less
WB: 21.6.21	Literacy: Start of Summer, information writing, assessed Independent writing task. Maths: Rec – Doubling and Halving, Nurs – Separating groups in different ways
WB: 28.6.21	Literacy: Keeping safe in the summer weather, making a poster, Maths: Rec – Odds and Evens, Nurs – representing numbers
WB: 5.7.21	Literacy: Fun in the sun, recounts of trips, postcard writing Maths: Rec – Counting beyond 20, Nurs – Counting lots of things and representing totals
WB: 12.7.21	Literacy: Seaside holidays past and present. Discussion and recounting anecdotes. Likes/dislikes Maths: Rec – revision and consolidation, Nurs – 1 more/1 less
WB: 19.7.21	Moving on – feelings, concerns, reflections and preparation.

Phonics will continue to be taught daily, for all children.

Reading books will be given to Reception children (Reading diaries checked daily for any messages but books will be changed on a Monday and a Thursday) and Books for Pleasure can still be selected by all the children.

Things you can do to help your child:

Please continue to talk to your children about their school experience and contribute to their Homework books when things are set. (Brain Builders will be set twice each half term)

You can help your child by encouraging them to dress and undress independently and to share their news with us.

Ask your child which sounds and red words they have been learning and encourage them to make sentences which they can write with your help

Please be aware – we are not permitted to apply sun-cream to your child. Please put this on at home, before they leave for school in the morning, and teach them how to top it up if necessary. Make sure any sun hats are clearly named.
