Information

Medicine in School

Just a reminder that if your child requires medication during the day, you should bring it to the school office first thing in the morning, where we can complete the relevant paperwork and then administer it when required. You can then collect the medication at the end of the day.

Children must not bring medicine in their bags or lunchboxes to administer themselves, for safety reasons

Sickness

If your child has been sick or had diarrhoea they must stay off school for 48 hours from the last bout, as per policy and guidance from the Health Protection Agency.

Please remember to call the school on the first morning of absence from school.

Coughs and Colds

Whilst we encourage children to attend school wherever possible, there are times when your child is unwell that they should stay at home to save infecting others. Recently lots of people seem to be picking up bugs brought in by children who are clearly unwell.

Summer Uniform

In the summer term the boys can wear shorts and the girls can wear the school blue striped summer dresses. If it is still a bit cold, and a petticoat or vest is not warm enough, please feel free to stay in the winter uniform until the warmer weather in mid May.
