#### New Starters

### Start of the Day

Please can all children arrive by 8:40am at the very latest so that they are ready for lessons at 8:45am.

On arrival between 8:15 and 8:40am children should walk up to the playground where they will be supervised before coming into school. On wet days children should come through the front door (which will be unlocked) and go to the hall where they will be supervised.

### End of the Day

At the end of the day children should be collected at 3:30pm from:

- Classroom 1 external door Class 1 children
  - Classroom 3 external door Class 3 children

unless they are staying for afterschool care.

On Friday children should be collected at **12:45pm** unless they are staying for Friday Club.

### **Collection from Clubs**

Children staying for clubs should be collected at 4:30pm. Please come to the front door and your child will be sent out to you at 4:30pm. Any child remaining after 4:30pm will be booked into Afterschool Care, which incurs an additional charge of £2.20. Afterschool Care finishes at 5:00pm.

For those children who are collected after 4:30pm or from Friday Club, please ring the front door bell and your child will be brought out to you.

### <u>Uniform</u>

It was lovely to see the children so smartly dressed as they came into school. Thank you.

### <u>PE Kits</u>

Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school every day and that all items, including PE bags are named. Class 3 will also need trainers as PE lessons will be outside to start with.

## <u>Swimming</u>

Children in Class 3 will start swimming lessons on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September. Children going swimming should wear their blue school tracksuits, gold polo shirts and trainers to school each Friday. They will need to bring their navy swimming trunks/costume, yellow DHS swimming hat and towel in their DHS swimming bag.

After swimming children should be collected from school at 12:45pm, unless they are staying for Friday Club.

As there is no swimming this week children can wear their normal school uniform.

## Music Lessons

Piano, violin, ukulele and guitar lessons will start on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September, with Mrs Teixeira, our peripatetic music teacher.

Charges for individual music lessons are invoiced directly by the music teacher and should be paid at the beginning of each term. The charge is £40 per half term (for six 15 minute lessons).
