### Harvest Festival - Wednesday 2nd October at 8:50am

The children are busy preparing for our Harvest Festival celebration in the school hall next Wednesday. All parents, families and friends are very welcome to attend.

Once again, we shall be supporting Grantham Foodbank which helps local individuals and families in crisis through the provision of emergency food supplies donated by churches, schools, businesses, and the general public. Last year, Grantham Foodbank distributed over <u>72 tonnes</u> of food to **8,698** local people in crisis, of whom <u>3,076</u> were children. An increase of <u>15</u>% from the previous year. Your support with food helps them to keep pace with the additional demand that they are experiencing. In August alone they provided **6,102** meals, an increase of **27**% from August 2023.
